Since 1938, Westside School (formally Madras Union High School and Madras Junior High) has seen thousands of students in its classrooms and playing on the grounds; teachers have stood in front of the chalk boards and coaches have supervised practices and games. Even more parents, family, community members, and visitors have attended conferences, plays and concerts, and FFA and FHA activities. Administrators have spent whole careers managing the educations of generations, and staff have quietly kept the buildings safe, comfortable and welcoming for more than 80 years.

In these interactions and activities are thousands of untold stories about people, places, events and experiences that are meaningful to generations of Jefferson County (and beyond) residents who consider (any version) of Westside School part of their personal history. The Bean Foundation, Jefferson County Historical Society and Jefferson County Library District are partnering to capture those memories in the forms of written stories, oral histories, photographs, and memorabilia.
